Day Trip Operations Manager

Our Day Trip Operations Manager is responsible for operational oversight of our ½ and 1 day trips. He/she reports to our General Manager.

- At least 18 years of age.

- At least one and preferably two or more seasons of commercial whitewater rafting experience.
- Strong organizational, problem solving, and people skills.
- Current First Aid and CPR certifications.
- Personable and friendly demeanor, and an enthusiasm for sharing the outdoors with guests.
- Strong work ethic, and the willingness to be a team player.
- Good health is a must: position involves occasional heavy lifting.
- Willingness to work varied and occasionally long hours. (This is not a conventional, 9 to 5 job)

Full time seasonal, 5-6 days per week. Flexible start and end dates (Mid-May or later through late August or later).
